



Small quantities of waste require self-delivery

As of: 1 January 2022



Acceptance for a charge:

For the delivery of waste up to 300 kg, there are three small quantity collection points in the Prignitz district (see back for addresses and opening times).

Bulky waste (20 03 07)

up to 50 kg	€ 5.00
over 50 kg and up to 150 kg	€ 15.00
over 150 kg and up to 300 kg	€ 30.00

Self-delivery of bulky waste up to 300 kg to the small quantity collection points is already included in the waste fees once a year and therefore does not have to be paid for separately.

Mineral construction waste (17 01 07)

up to 50 kg	€ 3.00
over 50 kg and up to 150 kg	€ 6.00
over 150 kg and up to 300 kg	€ 12.00

Building materials containing asbestos (17 06 05*)

up to 50 kg	€ 10.00
over 50 kg and up to 150 kg	€ 25.00
over 150 kg and up to 300 kg	€ 40.00

Mixed construction and demolition waste (17 09 04)

up to 50 kg	€ 5.00
over 50 kg and up to 150 kg	€ 15.00
over 150 kg and up to 300 kg	€ 30.00

Coal tar and products containing tar (17 03 03*)

(Delivery of roofing felt without adhesives)

up to 50 kg	€ 35.00
over 50 kg and up to 150 kg	€ 90.00
over 150 kg and up to 300 kg	€ 180.00

EPS insulation materials (styrofoam)

per bag, max. 120 litres	€ 30.00

Always free of charge:

Electrical and electronic equipment can be dispensed free of charge at the district small quantity collection points. Additional leaflets from the District of Prignitz provide information on the specifications regarding the disposal of electrical and electronic equipment.

Common household **portable batteries and accumulators** that do not contain any “free” liquids can be placed in the green or yellow collection containers provided.

Typical household scrap metal (scrap) is also accepted free of charge at the small quantity collection points.

The small quantity collection points have large paper and cardboard presses available for **waste paper, cardboard and cardboard packaging**.

Appropriate containers for **X-ray images** that are no longer required as well as used **CDs** and **DVDs** and **Blu-Ray Discs** (all without covers) are available for collection for proper recycling.

This also applies to empty **printer and toner cartridges**.

Harmful substances 4x per year:

In addition to its tour through the towns, the **harmful substances vehicle** stops at the small quantity acceptance points in the Prignitz district four times a year.

Appropriate collection containers are always available at the small quantity collection points for empty **PUR foam cans**.

Purchase non-recyclable waste bags:

Non-recyclable waste bags are available at all three small quantity collection points with on-site cash payment.

These bags can be used for temporary non-recyclable waste, e.g. at family celebrations or apartment renovations, and put out for collection on the day the waste bins are emptied.

The **charge** for a non-recyclable waste bag is **€ 5.00** for properties that are already supplied with a permanent waste bin.
